

Final Instruction 1 Issued on 13<sup>th</sup> of May 2018

Dear competitors,

We thank you for your entry for the event. Your seeded number can be found in the entry list as published on [www.Carlowcarclub.ie](http://www.Carlowcarclub.ie). The entry list will be kept up to date here as much as possible. If you are unable to start the event, please inform the event secretary **Brid Harpur, Ph.086-8403017 email [bridharpur@gmail.com](mailto:bridharpur@gmail.com)** as soon as possible. We will continue to accept entries.

1. All competitors please bring their Competition Licence to Recce Sign On where your licence will be kept till final sign on after scrutiny . This will help us greatly speed up document scrutiny later that day.

**PLEASE NOTE : Our rally office will open on Friday evening between the hours of 6pm to 8pm, reopening again on Saturday morning at 8.30am for Recce Sign on.**

2. Document and mechanical scrutiny will be at times as stated in event regulations. Mechanical Scrutiny will be held in Sheehy Motors green lane co Carlow (52.839172 -6.919771) from 3.30pm please try and be as early as possible to scrutiny. Sunday Scrutineering applications may be submitted to COC only.

3. Please attend paper scrutiny promptly after you finish mechanical scrutiny which starts from 4.30pm to 8.00pm

4. Trailer Park will be located in Burnside Eurocyl Ltd (52.8428400 – 6.9068330). Please park in a reasonable manner as not to impede others in this area. Marshals will be there to police this area. Unload your car and proceed from here to scrutiny.

5. Parc Ferme has now being changed and is now located in Thermo Air (52.8465920 -6.9305590). On passing mechanical scrutiny, **cars must proceed immediately into and remain in Parc Ferme**. Please park in a tidy manner. Absolutely no working on rally cars will be allowed in scrutiny or in parc ferme, including tyre changing.

6. Withdrawn entries will be treated as stated in the supplementary regulations for the event.

7. A Competitor Safety briefing (compulsory for all and a roll call will be conducted) will now be at 8.00am on Sunday morning and will be held in the function room upstairs in the HQ. This may be subject to change. Please see official notice board for updates.

8. Service Area will be located in Tullow Mart ( N52°47.948 -W006°44.519) Service area will be open on Saturday evening between the hours of 5.00pm & 7.00pm. please contact service area manager Brian Doyle on 087-2351163 for arrangements . Please do not leave any litter behind here or any other area used by the event.

9. It would be advisable for competitors, especially overseas crews, to familiarize themselves with the scrutiny requirements for Irish events and also check their relative IRDS/BRDS insurance .

10. In accordance with current regulations you will only be allowed three passes per stage or any part thereof during recce.

11. Competitors are reminded that no outside assistance is allowed on Irish events (other than to re-join a stage). Servicing will only be allowed in the area defined as the service area in the event's road book.

12. We would kindly ask if possible not to use any large vans or 4x4 jeeps for recce to keep inconvenience to other road users to a minimum. Please respect the residents and farmers on all stages. Misbehaving will not be tolerated on recce.

13. This year's event will once again allow a restart procedure (Rally 2). Please familiarize yourself with the details published in the event regulations.

**14. NON-POROUS GROUND SHEETS MUST BE USED IN THE SERVICE PARK AND COVER THE ENTIRE GROUND AREA UNDER THE RALLYCAR AND BE CAPABLE OF CATCHING ALL SPILLAGES. SERVICE CREWS NOT COMPLYING WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SERVICE AREA.**

**15. Any outstanding balances due for entry fees must be cleared in full before commencing Recce.**

16. REMEMBER all competing cars are required to enter and remain in Parc Ferme for 30 minutes after their "scheduled time in" at the conclusion of the event.

**17. THE EVENT SCRUTINEERS WILL BE CARRYING OUT SPOT CHECKS AT STAGE STARTS AND WILL PAY PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO THE PROPER FASTENING OF SAFETY HARNESES AND WEARING OF HANS DEVICES.**

19. Prize giving: If you are not attending prize giving please ensure you get someone to collect your prize on the night or you may forfeit your awards.

20. Pace Notes may be available for sale from Brian Patterson, Killian Duffy. The club has no involvement with their preparation or sale and accepts no responsibility for their accuracy or otherwise.
